Description

The sacred town of Reims is the capital of the Champagne region and known throughout the world for its noble sparkling wine; champagne. Reims is also the ancient city where most of the French kings were crowned.

Our morning orientation tour of Reims includes a guided visit of the gothic cathedral. At the superb Piper-Heidsieck champagne cellars, traditional carriages take us on a magical tour with recorded commentary in 7 languages. A champagne tasting completes the visit. Free time for lunch.

In the afternoon enjoy the picturesque landscape of vineyards between Reims and Epernay. At Epernay we visit the prestigious wine cellars of Moët & Chandon and sample their reputed wines.
