Description

Day 1: Aquitaine Motorway. Guided visit to the castle of Blois. Lunch on your own in Amboise. Guided visit to the Clos-Lucé, last dwelling of Leonardo da Vinci. Visit to the gardens of Villandry. Guided walking tour in the charming oldest part of the city of Tours.

Day 2: Chenonceau: guided visit to the castle. Cheverny: visit of the castle and farewell lunch at Hôtel Saint-Hubert. Afternoon: guided visit of the castle of Chambord.
