



## SIU REGISTRATION POLICY

### General Registration Guidelines

Anyone planning to attend an SIU Congress must be a registered participant. Various registration categories are available depending on the registrant's qualifications. Registration applications are reviewed and processed based on the assumption that they were completed accurately and honestly by the applicant. The registration category selected by the applicant will determine which scientific and/or social activities he/she is permitted to attend.

Exhibit badges will be issued only to people who are affiliated with a company that is an official Congress sponsor and/or exhibitor.

Only official Congress sponsors and exhibitors are permitted to display their products in the exhibit hall, as long as they remain within the confines of their booth. Anyone who is not affiliated with an official exhibitor or sponsor and is caught displaying products and/or soliciting participants in the meeting facility will be asked to leave the Congress venue immediately.

### Cancellation and Refund Policy

Delegates unable to attend SIU 2009 will receive a full refund (less 25% for administration charges), provided a written request is received by the Congress Office on or before September 18, 2009. The Congress regrets that requests received after this date will not be eligible. All approved refunds will be issued after the Congress.
